PCANZ Ohope Marae, Bay of Plenty

We are inviting *year 11-13* students from our Presbyterian Churches and Church Schools to join us for two amazing days of *fun, food, faith and leadership development* as we explore our bi-cultural past and future.

Hosted by Te Aka Puaho (*the PCANZ Maori Synod*) and the PYM Youth Leaders Network, our stay on the marae will provide an engaging learning experience around key themes of :

- Tikanga Maori
- The emergence of Christianity among Maori and how Te Ao Maori (the Maori worldview) and Christianity can be woven together
- The partnership between the Presbyterian Church and Te Aka Puaho
- The Treaty of Waitangi
- Leadership principles from Te Ao Maori

Each school or church is invited to nominate up to 5 year 11-13 students. Please discuss with us if you would like to nominate additional students.

Ideally students need to be accompanied by a youth leader, minister, chaplain or a teacher. Please discuss with us if you are not able to do so.

Additional bunk room accommodation is available at the adjacent *Ohope Christian Camp* which is immediately in front of the marae complex for \$18 per person per night.
